Determination for recognition of tax exempt status under section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code was approved on November 9, 2010.

Mission Statement

Dynasty Arts' mission is to provide educational training, literary development, workforce development and economic growth opportunities for creative and performing artists.

Purpose

Dynasty Arts' purpose is to create, refine, perform, exhibit and preserve significant artistic works of all cultures and periods.

Dynasty Arts provides individuals and organizations with access to local artistic works of cultural traditions and contemporary styles. Our collections of artistic resources are used for teaching and learning applications which integrates instructional online technology with traditional classroom training.

Dynasty Arts collaborates with other organizations to provide program services and activities that help to combat neighborhood tensions, community deterioration and juvenile delinquency.

To qualify for our programs, perspective candidates must first complete an application. An audition and interview may also be requested.

Programs

STUDIO 21© Performance Program

Studio 21© is a **tuition- free music performance program** that is designed to develop musicianship skills, academic proficiency and healthy social engagement in post-secondary students (over 17) who choose to pursue higher levels of study where academic degrees or professional certifications are awarded. Potential candidates must complete an application, placement test, interview and live music or dance audition to qualify for enrollment.

Once accepted into the program, groups of instrumentalists, vocalists and/or dancers are paired up with teaching staff that are trained to share their knowledge and talent for scripted, unscripted, spontaneous or otherwise carefully orchestrated performing arts routines from diverse cultures and music heritages. Flagship performances done live with an audience may involve **improvisational eurhythmic dance and spoken word**.

TUNE UP ©

MUSIC Education Program

TUNE-up is tuition-free music education program that is offered to children and youth (under 17 years of age) year-round. Classroom based lessons may include: music theory, music history, song writing, music notation, choreographed step routines, and genre focused instrumental group ensembles. For instrument lessons students may choose to learn: voice, guitar, piano, brass, bass and percussion instruments. There are two 16 week Terms: Fall (September – December), and Spring (January – May). During the summer (June – August), we focus on helping students with internships opportunities, mission trips, or summer job placements.

Minority Vendor Program (MVP)

Minority Vendor Program (MVP) **offers leadership training, workforce development and job creation/retention opportunities** for musicians and teaching artists by engaging them in live performances, recording productions, instructional media projects, classroom activities and literary works. MVP also has a **mentor/protégé** matching component which links professional artists to students who express an interest in finding out what it is like to be involved in a specific career or art discipline.

Associate Membership

Associate members are artists or art enthusiasts 18 years of age or older, who actively perform in their respective arts discipline. Modes of artistic expression may include music, dance, drama, literature, spoken word, video production, graphic arts, film production, and photography. **A \$50 per year donation includes a free listing in our web-based artist directory plus priority preference for work involving Dynasty Arts' educational programs and performance events.**
